Essentials of English Conversation

This course is designed to help students improve their English speaking skills. This course will give students the extra practice needed to become more fluent in English. Students will learn how to express themselves in everyday situation. Students will work on pronunciation, vocabulary and idioms. They also receive individualized feedback on grammar and pronunciation errors. Students are expected to actively participate in weekly discussion and activities. Upon completion of the course, students will receive a certificate of completion.

Essentials of English Writing

Students will develop sentence and paragraph writing skills. Focus will be on learning grammatical structures and using this knowledge within the writing context. Students learn to combine sentences to create meaningful and well-organized paragraphs. Students will be required to keep a journal in which they will practice new skills and express their views. Students will receive individualized instruction throughout the course. Upon completion of the course, students will receive a certificate of completion.

Essentials of English Grammar

Essentials of English grammar course covers count/noncount nouns, pronouns, adjectives, adverbs, basic sentence patterns, as well as the following verb tenses - simple present and past, present and past progressive, and future. These basic elements of English grammar are necessary for writing correct sentences and paragraphs. Students will receive individualized instruction throughout the course. Upon completion of the course, students will receive a certificate of completion.

American Literature Seminar : Ernest Hemingway

During the seminar, students will read several of Hemingway's short stories as well as one of his novels. The instructor will schedule weekly online discussions. Students will be responsible for the weekly reading, reading questionnaires, discussions and a final paper. Upon completion of the course, students will receive a certificate of completion.

Duration: 2 Months \$135

Essentials of English Reading

This reading course is a basic English as a second language reading comprehension course for students. Selections from literature, popular media, and academic texts are read and discussed. Students learn to employ specific reading and pre-reading strategies, expand their vocabulary, and increase their understanding of written English. Students are also challenged to speak and write about the concepts and issues addressed in the class readings. Students will receive individualized instruction throughout the course. Upon completion of the course, students will receive a certificate of completion.

Duration: 2 Months \$135

Intermediate English Writing Skills

During this course, students will develop writing skills that are needed to produce coherent essays in American English. Focus will be on the process of writing (prewriting activities, revising, editing), rhetorical formats, sentence structure, and grammar. This course emphasizes the development and organization of informative essays such as classification, cause/effect, and comparison/contrast. Students will receive individualized instruction throughout the course. Upon completion of the course, students will receive a certificate of completion.
